Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to be able to offer your child the opportunity to attend a trip to Blue Peris Mountain Centre in North Wales from Sunday 23rd to Friday 28th November 2025.

Your child will develop their leadership skills, communication, teamwork and social skills whilst learning how to overcome their fears in a challenging outdoor environment. They will experience activities such as gorge walking, sea level traversing, mining, rock climbing and abseiling. They will also experience the thrill and wonderful sense of achievement when they scramble to the top of a real mountain! We believe that the Blue Peris trip will give your child the priceless opportunity to experience a world full of natural challenges, both physical and mental, but very far removed from what has become the norm in modern society. With this in mind, we do not allow students to take mobile phones, games consoles or any other electrical devices on this trip. We believe that these measures will allow your child to get the very most from this fantastic experience.

The cost of the trip will be £434.25 - £503.00 depending on final numbers. Once we have received everyone's £100 deposit, a further letter will be sent out explaining the final cost and detailing the payment plan. The non-refundable £100 deposit must be paid to the Finance Department by Monday 3rd March 2025.

Payment can be made by cheque payable to Lealands High School or online using the link from our school website. Log on details have been supplied but if you require these again, please contact the Finance Department. The cost of the trip includes all transport, meals and activities undertaken during the trip. The only item you will need to buy for the trip is one pair of walking socks; everything else you will need is supplied by the centre.

The school reserves the right to refuse this opportunity if a student's conduct is deemed inappropriate for this visit at any time between now and the trip.

This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to experience a number of outdoor education activities in a safe and secure environment, under the supervision of highly trained and qualified staff. Please complete the reply slip if you would like your child to attend the trip. We require a minimum of 18 students for the trip to take place but can take up to a maximum of 40 students.
